That we Moses Barlow and Phebe Ann Barlow of the County of Polk and State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars in hand paid, do hereby sell and convey unto Benjamin Slader of the County of Polk and State of Iowa the following described premises, to-wit;

South West quarter of the South East quarter of Section Twenty six (26) in Township Seventy six (76) North of Orange Twenty seven (27) West of 5th P. M. Iowa -

And they do hereby covenant to Warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, and the said Phebe Ann Barlow hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises,
