Know all Men by these presents:

That we Charlotte Penner, formerly Charl-
ots, and Frederick Penner, her husband,

of the County of Pike in the State of Missouri, for and in consideration
of the sum of Six hundred dollars to us in hand paid, and secured to be
paid, by William Windecker of the County of Madison, in the State
of Iowa, do hereby, bargain, sell and convey unto the said W^m Windecker
and to his heirs and assigns forever the following described Real Estate
and premises, lying, being and situated in the County of Madison, in the
State of Iowa, to wit:

The East half of the North East quarter of Section Four(4) in Township
Seventy-six(76) North of Range Twenty-nine (29) West of 5th principal Meridian
Containing 80 Acres. - To have and to hold unto the said Wm Windecker
and to his heirs and assigns forever, the tract of ground aforesaid, with all
and singular the rights, improvements and appurtenances of the same.
And we hereby covenant with the said Wm Windecker that we hold said
premises by good and perfect title, that we have good right and lawful author-
ity to sell and convey the same, and that they are free and clear of all liens
and incumbrances whatever. - And we hereby covenant to warrant
and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
