Know all Men by these presents.

That William Early & Catharine W. Early husband & wife, of Madison County, State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Five hundred & fifty dollars, in hand paid, do hereby Sell and Convey unto George W. Wolverton of Madison County, and State of Iowa, the following described premises, to-wit:

The North East quarter of North West quarter of Section No Eleven (11) Township No Seventy six (76) Range Twenty nine (29), Madison County Iowa. —

And we do hereby covenant with the said George W. Wolverton that we are lawfully seized, in fee simple, of said premises, that they are free from Incumbrance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and we do hereby covenant to Warrant and defend the said premises and appurtenances thereto belonging against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Catharine W. Early hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above described premises. — Signed the 29th day of October A.D. 1864
