To all to whom these presents shall come;

I, J. J. Montgomery of the County of St. Louis and State of Missouri Administrator of the Estate of James Spencer late of St. Louis Mo. deceased, intestate, send greeting; Whereas, the personal Estate of said deceased was found inadequate to satisfy the charges against the said Estate and application having been made for license to sell so much of the Real Estate as would be sufficient therefor, after a full statement of all the claims against said Estate, and a full account of the disposition of the personal Estate had been rendered; and whereas, by an order of the County Judge of the said County of Madison Iowa made at a County Court held at Winterset in said County of Madison on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1865, I the said Administrator was licensed and empowered to sell and convey the Real Estate of the said James Spencer hereinafter described; and whereas I have caused the said Real Estate to be appraised and the appraisement duly filed according to law, all of which will more fully appear, reference being had to the records of said Court, and whereas, I the said Administrator having complied in all respects with the law in such cases required and with the order and direction of the said Madison County Court, did on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of November A.D. 1866, pursuant to the license aforesaid, sell by private sale the Real Estate hereinafter described; to Charles Conway, of the County of Madison and State of Iowa, for the sum of one hundred & Seventy dollars, that being the highest offered price therefor, and the appraised value thereof. — Now therefore, know ye, that I, the said J. J. Montgomery Administrator by virtue of the power and authority in me vested as aforesaid, and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and Seventy Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Charles Conway his heirs and assigns, all that certain tract or parcel of Real Estate, situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, described as follows, to wit;

The South half of the North West quarter of Section Twelve (12) Township Seventy six (76) Range Twenty nine (29), and also the North East quarter of the North East quarter of Section Thirty (30) in Township No. Seventy seven (77) Range Twenty eight (28).

To have and to hold, the above granted premises, with all the appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said James Spencer, his heirs and

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assigns forever. — And I, the said J. J. Montgomery Adam aforesaid do hereby covenant with the said Charles Conway his heirs and assigns, that in conducting said Sale, I have complied with all the requirements of the Law and of the said Madison County Court.
