That we James W. Cochran and Ellenor J. Cochran his wife of Clarke County and State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Four hundred dollars in hand paid by William Ferrall and Rachel Ferrall the Mother and heir at law of John Ferrall late deceased of Madison County, and State of Iowa, do hereby sell and convey unto the said William Ferrall and Rachel Ferrall the Mother and heir at law of John Ferrall late deceased, the following described premises situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa. To-wit:

The West half of the South East quarter of Section Twenty-four (24) Township Seventy-four (74) North, of Range Twenty-eight (28) containing Eighty acres more or less.

And we hereby covenant with the said William Ferrall and Rachel Ferrall the Mother and heir at law of John Ferrall late deceased, that we hold said premises by title in fee simple, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same, that they are free and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever, and we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whatsoever, and the said Ellenor J. Cochran hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
