Iowa do hereby sell and convey unto the said John E.
Harrison the following described premises, situated in the County
of Madison in the State of Iowa, to wit;

The North half of the North East quarter, and the South
West quarter of the North East quarter, the North East quarter of the
South West quarter, the South East quarter of the North West quarter,
of Section Twenty one (21) all in Township Seventy five (75) North
of Range Twenty nine (29) West of the 3rd Principal Meridian
Containing Two hundred acres according to the Government Survey.

And we do hereby covenant with the said John E. Harrison
or his assigns that we are lawfully seized of said premises; that
they are free from encumbrance; that we have good right and lawful
authority to sell the same; and we do hereby covenant to warrant
and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all
persons whomever. — And the said Evaline M. Crain hereby
relinquishes her right of dower in and to said premises.
