 Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said Sylvester Dalby his
 heirs and assigns forever, the following premises, situate in the County
 of Madison in the State of Iowa, and bounded and described as follows;

The South half of the North West quarter and the North
 West quarter of the North West quarter of Section number Thirty three
 (33) in Township number Seventy seven (77) North of Range Twenty =
 nine (29) 5th P.M. Iowa, containing One hundred and twenty
 (120) acres according to the Original Survey —

To have and to hold said premises, with the appurtenances, unto
 the said Sylvester Dalby his heirs and assigns forever. — And that the
 said Ozias M. Strong and Elizabeth Strong for themselves and heirs
 do hereby covenant with the said Sylvester Dalby his heirs and assigns
 that they are lawfully seized of the premises aforesaid, and that the prem-
