dollars in hand paid do hereby sell and convey unto Isaac Warden
of Madison County and State of Iowa, the following described
premises, to-wit;

Commencing at the South West corner, thence
Sixty rods North, forty rods East, Sixty rods South, forty rods
West to the place of beginning, of the North West quarter of the
North West quarter of Section fifteen (15) Township Seventy-
six (76) Range Twenty eight (28), containing fifteen acres.

And we do hereby warrant and defend the said
premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever,
and the said Minerva Jane Wolverton hereby relinquishes
all her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
