To: Will

I Samuel McFarland of the Borough
of Washington County of Washington
and State of Pennsylvania, do hereby make and publish this
my last will and testament.

First. — I direct that my Executor dispose of my estate Real and
personal, so soon as it can be done conveniently, and I hereby vest
in him full power to convey the real estate in fee simple in as full
a manner as I could do if I were living.

Second. — I bequeath to my Executor in trust to pay to my namesakes
Samuel McFarland Son of W^m S. McFarland dec^d, Samuel Harshman
son of John Harshman, Samuel Ingle son of Ashford P Ingles, Samuel
M. Youmans son of Samuel Youmans dec^d, Samuel M. Bane
son of J. Blossins Bane, Samuel Driver son of George Driver,
Samuel Frieze son of Geo. Frieze, Samuel McFarland son of
James McFarland, and Samuel Hanna son of — Hanna. One
hundred dollars each.

Third. — I bequeath to my Executor in trust to pay to my wife Mary
fifteen thousand dollars, this bequest is intended to include about
four thousand dollars which I received of my said wife's estate
shortly after we were married.

Fourth. — I bequeath to my Executor in trust, to be paid to the person
who when the same is payable shall act as Treasurer of the American
Missionary Association, New York City to be applied under the direction
of the Executive Committee of the Association to its charitable uses
and purposes twenty* thousand dollars.

Fifth. — I bequeath to the Western tract and book Society located in
Cincinnati Ohio, One thousand dollars, to be used in the perform-
ance of the work of said Society, under direction of the board of directors,

Sixth. — I bequeath to my Executor the residue of my Estate in trust
to pay the same to the person who when the same is payable shall
act as Treasurer of the said American Missionary Association to be
applied as above directed to its charitable uses and purposes.

Seventh. — It is my will that my Executor shall pay the foregoing bequests
so soon as they can be paid conveniently.

Eighth. — I ordain and constitute my Nephew Able M. Evans Executor
