to Tax Deed

Know all men by these presents:—That
 James Allen ~~whereas~~, the following described real property, viz;
 South East one fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the North West one fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$)
 of Section Twenty nine (29), Township Twenty seven (77) Range so Twenty
 eight (28) N. situated in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, was
 subject to taxation for the year A.D. 1863; and whereas the taxes, assessed upon
 said Real property, for the year aforesaid remained due and unpaid at the
 date of the sale hereinafter named: And whereas, the Treasurer of the said
 County did, on the 10th day of October 1864, by virtue of the authority in him
 vested by law, at the regular sale begun and publicly held on the 2^d
 Monday of October A.D. 1864, expose to public sale at Office of County
 Treasurer, in the County aforesaid in substantial conformity with all
 the requisitions of the statute in such case made and provided, the
 real property above described, for the payment of the taxes, interest
 and costs then due and remaining on said property.— And whereas
 at the time and place aforesaid H G Van Meter, of the County of Dallas
 and State of Iowa, having offered to pay the sum of One dollar &
 seventy five cents, being the whole amount of taxes, interest and costs then
 due and remaining unpaid on said property, for the whole of said forty
 acres, which was the least quantity bid for:— and payment of said sum, having
 been by him made to the said Treasurer, the said property was struck off
 to him at that price, & whereas the said H G Van Meter did on the 24th day
 of Apr. 1868, duly assign the certificate of the sale of the property as aforesaid,
 and all his right, title and interest to said property to James Allen of the
 County of Madison, and State of Iowa, and whereas, three years has elapsed
 since the date of said sale, and the said property has not been redeemed there-
 from as provided for by law: — Now, Therefore, I Wm S Leonard, Treasurer
 of the County aforesaid, for and in consideration of the said sum to the Treasurer
 paid as aforesaid, and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided
 have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and
 sell, unto the said James Allen his heirs and assigns, the real property last
 hereinbefore described, to have and to hold unto him the said James Allen
 his heirs and assigns forever: subject however to all the rights of redemption
 provided by law,
