(74). North of Range No Twenty-nine (29), Madison County, State of Iowa, and
we hereby covenant with the said Jacob W Rudy, that we hold said premises
by title in fee simple; that we have good right and lawful authority to sell and
convey the same; that they are free and clear of all liens and incumbrances
whatever, and we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against
the lawful claims of all persons whomever; - and the said Mary C Moore hereby
surrender her right of Dower in and to the above described premises,
