The West half, and North East quarter of the South West quarter of Section Twenty, in Township Seventy seven - North of Range Twenty nine, West, in the district of lands subject to sale at Fort Des Moines, Iowa, containing One hundred and Twenty acres, - Together with all the privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging.

To Have and to Hold the same to the only proper use of the said David Herman, his heirs and assigns forever. - And the said Nelson Kilby for his heirs, executors, and administrators, does hereby covenant with the said David Herman, his heirs and assigns, that he is the true and lawful owner of the said premises, and has full power to convey the same; and that the Title so conveyed, is clear, free, and unincumbered; - And further, that he will Warrant and Defend the same against all claim or claims of all persons whomsoever.
