Know all men by these presents:

That whereas, the following described pieces of Real Property, situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, viz:

- 1 The North East quarter of the South East quarter of section one in Township seventy four North of Range twenty eight West;
- 2 The South East quarter of the South East quarter of section one in Township seventy four North of Range twenty eight West;
- 3 The North West quarter of the South East quarter of section nine in Township seventy four North of Range twenty eight West;
- 4 The North East quarter of the North East quarter of section fifteen in Township seventy four North of Range twenty eight West;
- 5 The South East quarter of the North East quarter of section fifteen in Township seventy four North of Range twenty eight West;
- 6 The South West quarter of the South East quarter of section twenty two in Township seventy four North of Range twenty eight West;
