 State of Iowa, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey,
 to the said Samuel B. Arnold his heirs and assigns forever,
 the following described Real Estate situated in Madison
 County in the State of Iowa, to-wit:

The South East quarter of the North East quarter,
 and the North East quarter of the South East quarter of
 Section Thirty one (31) in Township Seventy six (76) North
 of Range Twenty six (26) West, Containing (80) Eighty Acres.
 And also the West half of the North West quarter and
 the North West quarter of the South West quarter of Section
 Thirty two (32) in Township Seventy six (76) North of Range
 Twenty six (26) West, estimated to contain One hundred
 and Twenty Acres, making in all Two hundred Acres
 more or less. — And the said Oliver Craven Executor and
 Nancy Campbell hereby warrant to said Samuel B. Arnold
