To { Deed Know all Men by these presents.
Burzillla Barker

That we Ransom Moon and Mary Moon his wife of Madison County, State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of Five hundred Dollars, in hand paid, do hereby Sell and Convey unto Burzillla Barker of Madison County, and State of Iowa the following described premises, to wit:

The South half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the South West quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty one (21) Township Seventy four (74) North Range Twenty nine (29) West of 5th Principal Meridian - Containing Eighty Acres more or less. —

And we do hereby covenant with the said Burzillla Barker that we are lawfully seized in fee simple, of said premises that they are free from incumbrance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and we do hereby covenant to Warrant and defend the said premises and appurtenances thereto belonging against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Mary Moon hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above described premises. — Signed, the 2 day of March A.D. 1868
