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J. M. Johnston Guar.
 To Deed

To all to whom these presents shall come: J. M. Johnston of Madison County, State of Iowa, Guardian of the persons and property of Lorinda Johnston, Catherine Johnston, Henrietta Johnston, Eliza Johnston and Nancy Ellen Johnston sends greeting; Whereas, the said J. M. Johnston Guardian as aforesaid, heretofore to-wit; at the November Session A.D. 1866 of the County Court of Madison County and State of Iowa, made application to the said Court, to sell certain hereinafter described lands belonging to said minors. — And Whereas, Notice of said application was duly and personally served upon said minors according to law; — And whereas also, at the said November term A.D. 1866 of said County Court, the said J. M. Johnston in his capacity of Guardian aforesaid was ordered and empowered to sell said lands. — And whereas, also, The said Guardian has given the Bond with sureties required by law. — And whereas also, the said Guardian has sold the Real Estate herein after described, (being a part of the said Real Estate which the said Guardian was empowered to sell by said order of said County Court) to J. J. Rhyne of Madison County, in the State of Iowa for the sum of Twenty nine hundred seventy two Dollars.

Now Therefore, Know ye, That I, the said, J. M. Johnston in my capacity of Guardian as aforesaid, by virtue of the authority

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vested in me by said County Court, and in pursuance of the said order of said Court, in consideration of the said sum of Twenty nine hundred and seventy two Dollars, to me paid by the said J. J. Rhyno (the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge) do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. J. Rhyno, and to his heirs and assigns forever, the following described tracts of Real Estate, lying and being situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, to wit;

The undivided five eights part of the North fractional half of Section Six (6) and the North West fractional quarter of Section Five (5), and two acres bounded as follows, commencing at the North West corner of the North East quarter of Section Five (5) thence South twenty six rods ten and one third feet, thence East twelve rods, thence North twenty six rods ten and one third feet, thence West twelve rods to the place of beginning, all said lands being in Township Seventy four (74) Range Twenty six (26) West of 5th P. M.

To have and to hold, the said described premises unto the said J. J. Rhyno his heirs and assigns forever. - And I the said J. M. Johnston as Guardian for myself, my executors and administrators do hereby covenant with the said J. J. Rhyno his heirs and assigns, that in making the said sale, I have in all things observed and complied with all the requisitions of the law, and that as guardian as aforesaid, I will Warrant and defend, the above granted premises to the said J. J. Rhyno against the lawful claims of said minors and all persons claiming or to claim the same by, through, or under them.
