Know all men by these Presents
 That Whereas, the following described real
 property viz North West $\frac{1}{4}$ of North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section No
 Twenty four (24) Township No Seventy six (76) North, Range
 No Twenty seven (27) West situated in the County of Madison
 and State of Iowa, was subject to taxation for the years A.D. 1861
 & 1862, and whereas the taxes, assessed upon said real property, for the
 years aforesaid remained due and unpaid at the date of the sale here-
 inafter named; and whereas, the Treasurer of the said County did, on the
 11th day of May 1864, by virtue of the authority in him vested by law
 at the adjourned tax sale begun and publicly held on the 3rd Monday
 of May A.D. 1864, expose to public sale at the Treasurers Office
 in the County aforesaid in substantial conformity with all the requi-
 sitions of the statutes in such case made and provided, the real
 property above described, for the payment of the taxes, interest and
 costs then due and remaining unpaid on said; and whereas, at the time
 and place aforesaid Thomas Garlinger of the County of Madison
 and State of Iowa, having offered to pay the sum of Three Dollars
 Eighteen cents being the whole amount of taxes, interest and costs
 then due and remaining unpaid on said property, for N $\frac{1}{4}$ of E
 $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec (24) Town (76) North, Range No (27) West, forty acres
 which was the least quantity bid for; and payment of said sum
 having been by him made to the said Treasurer, the said property
 was stricken off to him at that price, and Whereas the said
 Thomas Garlinger has assigned the certificate of purchase to
 H. L. McCarty, and whereas three years has elapsed since the

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date of said sale and the said property has not been redeemed therefrom as provided for by law;

Now therefore, I, W. L. Leonard, Treasurer of the County aforesaid, for and in consideration of the said sum ~~of~~ the Treasurer paid as aforesaid, and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided, have granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said H. L. McCarty, his heirs and assigns, the real property last hereinbefore described, to have and to hold unto him the said
