Five Acres in the South East corner of the South West quarter of the North East quarter of Section Three (3) in Township Seventy four (74) Range Twenty seven (27) West of 5th P. M. and we also release all claim for damage on account of misdescription of land in deeds of any and all dates, said five acres being 40 rods N & S - & 20 rods East and West.

And the said Angeline Haynes releases all her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
