(26) West of the 5th P. M. Iowa, Containing 40 acres more or less -

And all the Estate, Title and Interest of the said W. B. Beebe
either in Law or Equity, of, in and to the said premises: Together
with all the privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging, and
all the rents, issues and profits thereof: To have and to hold the same to
the only proper use of the said James Kirby heirs and assigns forever.

And the said Walter B. Beebe & Maria B. Beebe wife of
Walter B. Beebe for themselves and for their heirs, executors and
Administrators, do hereby covenant with the said James Kirby

his heirs and assigns, that they are the true and lawful owner of the said premises, and have full power to convey the same; that the title, so conveyed, is clear, free and unencumbered, and further, that they will warrant and defend the same against all claim, or claims of all persons whomsoever.
