To all people to whom these presents shall come, - Greeting;

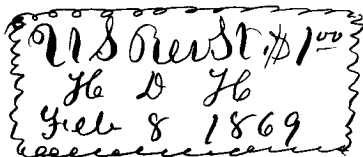

The South half of Section Seventeen (17), in Township Seventy-seven (77) N. of Range Twenty nine (29) West in the District of lands subject at Fort Des Moines, Iowa, containing three hundred and twenty acres more or less,

To have and to hold the premises aforesaid, unto the said Grantee, his heirs and assigns, so that neither we, the said Grantors, or our heirs nor any other persons claiming title through or under us shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the premises, or any part thereof; but they and every one of them shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred. - And I, the said Christina Holderbaum wife of said Henry D.
