That we E. W. Fuller and his wife Maria P. Fuller

 the sum of Ten (\$10.00) DOLLARS,
 in hand paid by Martha S. Reynolds
 of Madison County and State of Iowa do hereby SELL AND CONVEY unto the said
Martha S. Reynolds
 the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

Two Acres in a square form in the North West
 corner of the South half of the North West quarter of the South
 West quarter of Section No Twenty (20) in Township
 No Seventy six (76) North; of Range No Twenty seven (27)
 West 5th P. M. Iowa, being Seventeen & Eighty eight one-
 hundredths (17⁸⁸/₁₀₀) square. —

And we hereby covenant with the said Martha S. Reynolds
 that we hold said premises by good and perfect title, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell
 and convey the same; that they are free and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we
 covenant to WARRANT AND DEFEND the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever: and the said
Maria P. Fuller hereby relinquishes her right of Dower
 in and to the above described premises.
