And we do hereby covenant to Warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, claiming by, through, or under us; and the said Mary A. Hough hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above described premises. - Signed this 13th day of October A.D. 1869.
