Know all Men by these presents,

That Jonathan Wissler and Elizabeth M. Wissler his wife of the County of Pickaway State of Ohio in consideration of the sum of Twelve hundred Dollars, to them paid by Adam C. Krell of the County of Ross, State of Ohio, have bargained and sold, and do hereby grant and convey unto the said Adam C. Krell his heirs and assigns, forever, the following premises, situate in the County of Madison in the State of Iowa, and bounded and described as follows;

The East half of the North West quarter, and the South West quarter of the North East quarter of Section number Twenty three (23) Township Seventy four (74) North, Twenty eight (28) West. - Containing One hundred and twenty Acres of land more or less.

To have and to hold said premises, with the appurtenances, unto the said Adam C. Krell his heirs and assigns forever. - And the said Jonathan Wissler and Elizabeth M. Wissler his wife for themselves and their heirs, do hereby covenant with said Adam C. Krell his heirs and assigns, that they are lawfully seized of the premises aforesaid; that said premises are ~~free~~ and clear from all incumbrances whatsoever; and that they will forever warrant and defend the same, with the appurtenances, unto the said Adam C. Krell his heirs and assigns, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
