The Undivided one half of the following described lands. The North West fractional quarter of the North West quarter of Section No Four (4) in Township No Seventy six (76) North of Range No Twenty eight (28) North. - Also the South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section No Thirty two (32) in Township Seventy seven (77) North of Range Twenty eight (28) West. - Also the South West quarter of the South West quarter of Section No Thirty three (33) in Township No Seventy seven (77) North of Range No Twenty eight (28) West.

And we warrant the title to the same to the said John Ball against all persons whomsoever. - Executed this 6<sup>th</sup> day of January A.D. 1862.
