This Indenture, made this twenty fifth
day of August in the year of our Lord
One thousand Eight hundred and sixty eight (1868)

Between John H. Sangley of the City of Rock Island, in the County of Rock
Island and State of Illinois, and Sarah P. Sangley his wife, parties of the
first part, and Stephen M. Harris of the said City of Rock Island, and County
and State aforesaid party of the second part; Witnesseth that the said
parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty Dollars,
lawful money of the United States to them in hand paid by the said Stephen
M. Harris, party of the second part at or before the sealing and delivery of
these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have remised, released,
and quit-claimed, and by these presents do remise, release and quit claim
unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all
that certain piece or parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Madison,
and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The NE¹/₄ of the NE¹/₄ Section Eleven (11) Township Seventy six (76)
North of Range Twenty nine (29) West of the fifth (5th) Principal Meridian,
and containing forty Acres (40) more or less. — Together with all and singular
the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise
appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues
and profits thereof, and also all the estate, right, title, interest, dower and right of dower,
property, possession, claim and demand whatsoever, as well in law as in equity,
of the said parties of the first part, of, in, or to the above described premises, and
every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances. To have and to hold, all
and singular the above mentioned and described premises, together with the appurte-
nances, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever.
