in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred

and Sixty eight (1868), Between John Weir and Eleanor Weir

his wife of Chicago Cook County Illinois party of the first part, and Robert
Weir of the same place party of the second part, - Witnesseth, That the said party
of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid
by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
and the said party of the second part forever released and discharged therefrom,
have Remised, Released, Sold, Conveyed and Quit Claimed and by these presents do
Remise, Release, Sell, Convey and Quit Claim unto the said party of the second part,
his heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand which
the said party of the first part have in and to the following described lots,
pieces or parcels of land, to wit;

The North Fifty (50) Acres of the East half of the South West
quarter, and the North Fifty (50) Acres of the West half of the South East
quarter of Section Twenty four (24) in Township Seventy six (76) North of Range
Twenty seven (27) West lying and being in the Township of Union in the County
of Madison and State of Iowa, and being the interest of said John in said
premises under a patent thereof from the United States to said John and
Robert dated Oct. 30. A.D. 1857, Recorded in Book or Volume 34 on page 152,
in the General Land Office at Washington D. C.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and
privileges therunto belonging or in anywise thereto appertaining; and all the estate,
right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said party of the first part, either in law or
equity, to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part his
heirs and assigns forever. - In witness whereof, the said party of the first part hereunto

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being fully informed of her rights under the Homestead Laws of this State,
acknowledged that she had freely and voluntarily executed the same, and
relinquished her claim to the lands and tenements therein mentioned,
and also all her rights and advantages under and by virtue of all
laws of this State relating to the exemption of homesteads, without the
compulsion of her said husband, and that she does not wish to retract
