Leavitt and A. J. Lusch of Waterloo, County of Black Hawk, and State of Iowa, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey to the said John H. Leavitt and A. J. Lusch their heirs and assigns forever, the following Real Estate in Madison County, in the State of Iowa, to wit;

The North West Quarter of Section No Twelve (12) in Township Seventy seven (77) North of Range Twenty eight (28) Containing One hundred & Sixty (160) Acres,

And all the Estate, Title and Interest of the said Jacob Nettler and Amalia Nettler his wife either in Law or Equity, of, in and to the said premises; Together with all the privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging, and all the rents, issues and profits thereof; To have and to hold the same to the only proper use of the said John H. Leavitt and A. J. Lusch their heirs and assigns forever.

And the said Jacob Nettler for himself, and for his heirs, executors, and administrators, does hereby Covenant with the said John H. Leavitt and A. J. Lusch their heirs and assigns, that he is the true and lawful owner of the said premises, and has full power to convey the same; and the Title, so conveyed, is Clear, Free, and Unencumbered; and further, that he will Warrant and defend the same against all claim, or claims, of all persons whomsoever, Except as to any Taxes that may be due or become payable upon said premises, or any Tax title or titles that may exist upon the same.— In Witness Whereof, the said Jacob Nettler and Amalia Nettler his wife who hereby releases all right and expectancy of Dower in the said premises, have hereunto set their hands and seals, this fourth day of November, in the year of our Lord, One thousand, eight hundred and sixty eight.
