Know all Men by these presents:

That Richard Beall and Jemima Beall his wife of the County of Madison and State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Four thousand (\$4000<sup>00</sup>) dollars, in hand paid by Samuel Welch of Madison County, and State of Iowa, do hereby sell and convey unto the said Samuel Welch the following described premises, situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, to-wit;

The South half of the North West quarter and the East half of the North East quarter of the South West quarter of Section Twenty (20), and the East half of the South West quarter of the South East quarter of Section Four (4) all in Township Seventy five (75) North of Range Twenty seven (27) West of 5<sup>th</sup> P. M.

And I hereby covenant with the said Samuel Welch that I will warrant and defend the title to said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, except a Mortgage to the School Fund for \$126<sup>00</sup>.

And the said Jemima Beall hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
