 this 29th day of January A. D. 1869, by and between
 Christopher Brown of the County of Cedar and

State of Iowa, party of the first part, and John W. Dabney of Madison County
 State of Iowa of the second part, Witnesseth; That the said party of the first part,
 for and in consideration of the sum of Two (2) thousand four (4) hundred
 dollars, to him paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt of which
 is hereby acknowledged, has granted and sold, and do by these presents,
 Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and Confirm unto the said party of the second part,
 his heirs and assigns forever, the certain tract or parcel of Real Estate, in the County
 of Madison, State of Iowa, to-wit;

The West half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the South East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) and the East half ($\frac{1}{2}$)
 of the South West quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section No Nineteen (19) Township Seventy six
 (76) Range Twenty eight (28). —

To have and to hold, the premises above described, with all the appurte-
 nances thereto belonging, unto him the said second party and to his heirs
 and assigns forever. — The said Christopher Brown hereby covenan-
 ting for his heirs, executors and administrators, that the above descri-
 bed premises are free from any incumbrance; that he has full right,
 power and authority to sell the same, and he will Warrant and defend
 the title unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns,
 against the claims of all persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming the same.
