Beall of Madison County, and State of Iowa, do hereby sell and convey unto the said Leonara B. Beall the following described premises, situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The South half of the North East quarter of the North West quarter, also the North half of the South East quarter of the North West quarter of Section No Twenty four (24) (Except a strip one rod west on the West line of the same) Also ten Acres off the North side of the North five eights part of the South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section Fourteen (14), all in Township Seventy six (76) North of Range Twenty eight West of 5<sup>th</sup> P. M. Iowa. —

And we hereby covenant with the said Leonara B. Beall that we will warrant and defend the title to said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, — And the said Gemima Beall hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises. — Signed the twenty third day of January 1869.
