That we Abel W. Likins and May Jane Likins of Madison County, State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Four hundred dollars, in hand paid, do hereby sell and convey unto James F. Johnson of Madison County and State of Iowa, the following described premises, to-wit;

The South West quarter of the North West quarter of Section No Twenty one (21) & the North West quarter of the North East quarter of Section No Twenty (20) in Township No Seventy five (75) Range No Twenty nine (29) in Madison County & State of Iowa. —

And we do hereby covenant with the said James F. Johnson that we are lawfully seized of said premises; that they are free from incumbrances; that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same; and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whosoever; and the said May Jane Likins hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
