wife of the said J. M. Pindell of the County of
Brown, Ohio, in consideration of the sum of One thousand (1000) dollars
in hand paid by Anderson Shaw of the same place, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged do hereby bargain sell and convey to the said
Anderson Shaw his heirs and assigns forever, the following described
real estate lying and being in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa:

Being the East half of South West qr. of Section Two (2)
and the South East qr. of South East qr. of Section Two (2) in Township
No 74 North of Range No 29 W. containing One hundred and twenty
Acres (120). — And all the estate title and interest of the said
J. M. Pindell either in law or in equity of in and to the said
premises together with all the privileges and appurtenances to
the same belonging, to have and to hold the same to the only proper
use of the said Anderson Shaw his heirs and assigns forever
and the said J. M. Pindell for himself, heirs, executors and adminis-
trators hereby covenant with the said Anderson Shaw his heirs
and assigns that he is the true and lawful owner of the said prem-
ises and has full power to convey the same and that the title so conveyed
is clear and free and unencumbered and further that he will warrant
and defend the same against all claim or claims of all persons whatsoever
