 nal survey, and also the North half of the North East quarter of Sec-
 tion Twenty five (25) in Township seventy seven (77) North of Range
 Twenty seven (27) West of 5th P.M. Iowa, and containing Eighty acres
 according to original survey, being situated in the County of
