Thomas H. Simmons

To all to whom these Presents shall come,
 Benjamin F. Brown of Madison County, State
 of Iowa, Guardian of the persons & property of
 Eliza Roberts, William Roberts, Clark J. Roberts & Hannah Roberts,
 minor heirs of Benjamin Roberts deceased, and, greeting, Whereas,
 the said B. F. Brown guardian as aforesaid, heretofore to wit, at
 the March session A.R. 1867 of the County Court of Madison County
 and State of Iowa, made application to the said Court to sell
 the interest of his said heirs, it being the four fifths $\frac{4}{5}$ of
 certain lands described in his petition filed March 19, 1867,
 and whereas, notice of said application was duly and personally
 served upon said minors according to law, And whereas,
 at the said March Term A.R. 1867 of said County Court, the said
 B. F. Brown in his capacity of Guardian, aforesaid, was ordered
 and empowered to sell said interests aforesaid, in said Real
 Estate, And whereas, also, the said Guardian has given the bond
 with securities required by law, And whereas, also, the said Guardian
 has sold the Real Estate hereinafter described, being a part of the
 said Real Estate which the said Guardian was empowered to
 sell by said order of said County Court to Thomas H. Simmons
 of Madison County, in the State of Iowa, for the sum of Five Thousand
 and Four Hundred and Eighty (2480) Dollars, Now, therefore, Know
 ye, that I, the said B. F. Brown in my capacity of Guardian as
 aforesaid, by virtue of the authority vested in me by said County
 Court, and in pursuance of the said order of said Court, in
 consideration of the sum of Five Thousand Four Hundred and
 Eighty (\$2480) Dollars, to me paid by the said Thomas H. Simmons,
 the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge, do by these presents, Grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto the said Thomas H. Simmons, and
 to his heirs and assigns forever, the following described tract of
 Real Estate, lying and being situated in the County of Madison
 and State of Iowa. To wit,

The undivided $\frac{4}{5}$ of $\frac{3}{4}$ of $\frac{3}{4}$ of Section 1, Tp 7th, R 2d, and
 the $\frac{1}{2}$ of $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, and the $\frac{1}{2}$ of $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Tp 7th, R 2d -
 containing 120 acres more or less. To Star and to Hold,
 the said described premises unto the said Thomas H. Simmons
 and his heirs and assigns forever. And I, the said B. F.
 Brown, Guard for myself, my executors and administrators,
 do hereby covenant with the said Thomas H. Simmons,
 and to his heirs and assigns, that in making the said sale,

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I have in all things observed and complied with all the requisitions of the law, and that as Guardian aforesaid, I will warrant and defend the above granted premises to the said Thomas H. Simmons against the lawful claims of said minors, and all persons claiming or to claim the same, through or under them.
