Know all men by these presents:

That we Robert D. Tisdale and his wife Gerilda Tisdale of the County of Madison and State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, do hereby Quit Claim unto Hogan Queen of Madison County, and State of Iowa, all our right, title and interest in and to the following described land, situate and lying in Madison County, and State of Iowa, To wit:

The South East 1/4 quarter of the South West quarter of Section Seven (7) in Township No Seventy five (75) North of Range No Twenty six (26) West of 5th P.M. Iowa, and the said Gerilda Tisdale hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
