To 3 Guardians Died

472 Uriah H Stoggatt Know ye that I Fanny Maxwell of Madison County, State of Iowa, Guardian of the persons and property of Mary M Maxwell, Hannah B Maxwell & Henry Y Maxwell minors sende greeting, Whereas the said Fanny Maxwell, Guardian as aforesaid, heretofore, to wit: at the March session A.D. 1865 of the County Court of Madison and state of Iowa, made application to the said Court, to sell certain lands belonging to her said wards, And Whereas, Notice of said application was duly and personally served upon said minor, according to law, and Whereas, also, at the said March Term A.D 1865, of said County Court, the said Fanny Maxwell in her capacity of Guardian aforesaid was ordered and empowered to sell said hereinafter described land, And Whereas, also, the said Guardian has given the Board with securities required by law, And Whereas, also, the said Guardian has sold the Real Estate hereinafter described, (being all of the said Real Estate which the said Guardian was empowered to sell by said order of said County Court), to Uriah H Stoggatt of Madison County in the state of Iowa, for the sum of One Hundred Dollars, Now Therefore, Know ye, That I the said Fanny Maxwell in my capacity of Guardian as aforesaid, by virtue of the authority vested in me by said County Court, and in pursuance of the said order of said Court, in consideration of the said sum of One Hundred Dollars, to me paid by the said Uriah H Stoggatt, (the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge) do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Uriah H Stoggatt, and to his heirs and assigns forever, the following described tract of Real Estate, siting and being situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, to wit:

The South West quarter of the North East quarter of Section No 32 Thirtieth two Township No (44) Seventy four, Range No (26) Twenty six, subject to dover of widow the wife, To Stan and To Hold, the said described premises unto the said Uriah H Stoggatt his heirs and assigns forever, And I, the said Fanny Maxwell for myself, my executors and administrators do hereby covenant with the said Uriah H Stoggatt his heirs and assigns, that in making the said sale, I have in all things observed and complied with all the requisitions of the law, and that as Guardian as aforesaid, I will warrant and defend

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the above granted premises to the said Uriah H Hoggatt against the lawful claims of said minors and all persons claiming or to claim the same by, through or under them,
