That we Chester Hunt and Sadie Hunt, his wife, of  
Hinderset, Madison County, State of Iowa, in consideration of the  
sum of Three Hundred Dollars in hand paid by John H Stiffler of the  
same place do hereby sell & convey unto the said John H Stiffler  
the following described premises to wit:

Lot No Sixteen 16, in Kellison's Ratings addition to the city  
of Holderset Iowa, and we hereby covenant with the said John  
H Stiffler that we hold said premises by good and perfect  
title, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell &  
convey the same, that they are free from all incumbrances  
whatsoever & we covenant to warrant & defend the said prem-  
ises against the lawful claims of all persons whosoever, and  
the said Sadie Hunt hereby relinquishes her right of dower  
in and to the same.
