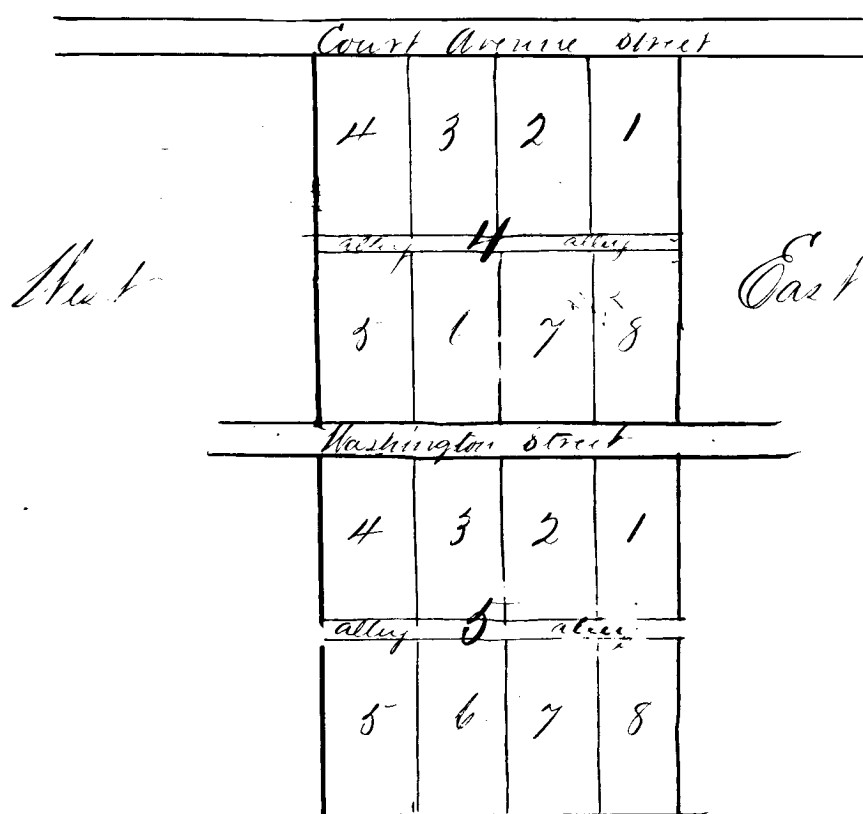

Know all men by these presents; That the N. R. Shriver & Martha J. Shriver, of the County of Madison, in the State of Iowa, are the unqualified owners in fee simple of Lots One, Two, Three, Four, Five, Six, Seven, Eight in Block Four, Cassiday & Doughridge's addition to the City of Winterset Madison County, Iowa, and also Lots Number One, Two, Three, Four, Five, Six, Seven, & Eight, in Block Number Five (Cassiday & Doughridge's addition to the City of Winterset, Iowa. The following is a copy of such plat or so much thereof as refers to said Blocks Four & Five,



And that by and in conformity with Chapter Seventy Eight Laws of the Ninth General Assembly of the State of Iowa, do declare so much of the town plat of said addition of Cassiday & Doughridge, to the said City of Winterset, Iowa, vacated as pertains and relates to Block 2, Four & Five thereof, as above platted, That is to say the street running East & West through and between said Blocks Four & Five, known and platted & recorded as Washington Street, and each of the alleys running East & West through said Blocks Four & Five, are hereby vacated, and all public rights in said Street and alleys are hereby divested.
