Shaw of Madison County, and State of Iowa, the following described Real Estate, situated in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to wit:

East 1/2 South West 1/4 of Section Eighteen 18, Town Sixty seven 77, Range Twenty seven 27 containing eighty acres, also part of South East South West 1/4 Section Twenty nine 9, 77, Range 27, containing 4<sup>th</sup> acres, and the said John T. Perkins, and Jemima T. Perkins, Isaac Perkins, and David Perkins, Joseph L. Perkins, and Lydia Perkins his wife, hereby relinquishes all right, interest or claim of dower, in and to said land and the said grantors, hereby covenant to warrant and defend the title to the said premises, against the lawful claims of all persons whatsoever.
