 unto the said Grantee, his heirs and assigns, forever, all such right  
 and title as over the said Grantor, have or ought to have in and to the  
 following described premises, situated in the County of Madison, and State of  
 Iowa, bounded & known as,

The North East quarter of the North West quarter section forty three,  
 and South West of South West quarter of Section twenty four, and North East  
 quarter, East quarter of North West quarter of Section Thirteen, of land  
 lying in Township Twenty four of Range Twenty six, West, containing One  
 hundred and twenty acres, also the South West quarter of North East quarter  
 of section Twenty nine, E. of Range No Twenty six, West, containing Part of  
 acre, To have, and to Hold the premises aforesaid, unto the said  
 Grantee, his heirs and assigns, so that neither we, the said Grantor, or our
