The south West quarter of the North East quarter of Sec 9, nine, in Township
7th, twenty four, Range 27, Twenty seven, And we do hereby covenant with
the said Joseph Harwood, that we do hold said premises by good and
perfect title, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell and
convey the same, that they are free and clear of all liens and incum-
brances whatever, And we do covenant to warrant and defend the said
premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, And the
said Alice M Anderson hereby relinquishes her right of Dower in and
to the above described premises, Signed this 3rd day of March A.D. 1869
