Know all Men by these presents,  
 That we John A. Pitzer and Elizabeth J.  
 Pitzer wife of the said John A. Pitzer of the County  
 of Madison and State of Iowa in consideration of the natural love and  
 affection which we bear toward our Son J. M. Pitzer of Madison County  
 and State of Iowa do hereby sell and convey unto the said J. M. Pitzer  
 the following described premises, situated in the County of Madison and  
 State of Iowa, to wit:

Commencing at a point twenty one (21) rods North of the South East  
 corner of the South West quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the North West quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section number  
 thirty one (31) of Township number Seventy six (76) of Range number Twenty seven (27)  
 West of 5<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, running thence West fifty five (55) rods to  
 the South East corner of block number Two (2) of Pitzer and Knights addition  
 to the City of Winterset; thence North on a line with the West side of Jackson Street  
 in the original town of Winterset, to a point thirty (30) rods North of the North end of  
 said Jackson Street; thence East twelve and one half (12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) rods; thence North thirteen  
 (13) rods; thence West twelve and one half (12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) rods; thence North to a point  
 forty (40) rods East of the North West corner of the South West quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the North  
 West quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section number Thirty one (31) of Township number Seventy-  
 six (76) of Range number Twenty seven (27) West of 5<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian; thence  
 East to the North East corner of said last above described tract of land; thence  
 South to the place of beginning; containing (19 $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Nineteen and one quarter Acres  
 more or less. — Also commencing at the North East corner of Block number  
 twelve (12) of Pitzer & Knights addition to the City of Winterset, thence West on the  
 North line of said Block to the North West corner of said block, thence South eight  
 (8) rods; thence East Sixteen (16) rods; thence South One (1) rod; thence West sixteen  
 (16) rods; thence South to the South West corner of said block; thence West four (4) rods;  
 to the South East corner of Block number thirteen (13) of Pitzer and Knights  
 addition to the City of Winterset; thence North Eight (8) rods; thence West  
 Sixteen (16) rods; thence North One (1) rod; thence East Sixteen (16) rods; thence  
 North eight (8) rods to the North East corner of said Block number Thirteen (13);  
 thence West Sixteen (16) rods; thence North thirty — (30) feet; thence East  
 thirty six (36) rods; thence South thirty — (30) feet to the place of beginning.

Also lots numbers One (1), two (2), three (3), four (4), five (5), six (6), seven (7),  
 and eight (8) in Block number Twelve (12); also lots numbers One (1),  
 two (2), three (3), four (4), five (5), six (6), seven (7) and Eight (8) in Block number  
 Thirteen (13); both and each of said Blocks number twelve (12) and thirteen  
 (13) being in Pitzer and Knights addition to the City of Winterset.

And we hereby covenant with the said J. M. Pitzer that we hold said  
 premises by good and perfect title, that we have good right and lawful authority

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to sell and convey the same, that they are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances whatsoever; - And we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever. - And the said Elizabeth J. Pitzer hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
