Know all Men by these presents,

That I, George Smith of Adair County, State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of One hundred and thirty dollars in hand paid do hereby sell and convey unto D. C. Holmes of Madison County, and State of Iowa, the following described premises, to-wit:

Commencing at the North East corner of the North West quarter of Section Six (6) Township Seventy six, Range Twenty nine (29), running Eighty two rods South, thence West Twenty rods to the North East corner of said land, now running Twenty seven rods West, thence South Seventeen rods, and Eleven feet, thence East Twenty seven rods, thence North Seventeen rods and Eleven feet to the place of beginning. — Containing three Acres,

and I do hereby covenant with the said D. C. Holmes that I am lawfully seized of said premises, that they are free from Incumbrance, that I have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same, and I do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises and appurtenances thereto belonging against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; — Signed the 31st day of March A.D. 1869
