Simmons of Madison County and State of Iowa do hereby sell and convey unto the said Alfred R. Simmons the following described premises, situated in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa to wit:

The South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section No Seven (7) in Township No Seventy four (74) North of Range No Twenty six (26) West of 5th P.M. Iowa, containing forty (40) acres more or less. — And we hereby covenant with the said Alfred R. Simmons that we hold said premises by title in fee simple; that we have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same; that they are free and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever.

And we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomever. — And the said M. R. Kerns hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises. —
