Fields of the second part; Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, doth by these presents grant, bargain, sell, remise, release, alien and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

The North West quarter of the South West quarter of Section No Fourteen (14) in Township No Seventy five (75) of Range No Twenty eight (28) West, containing Forty Acres more or less.

Also the South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section No Twenty three (23) in Township No Seventy five (75) of Range No Twenty nine (29) West, containing Forty Acres more or less. (Subject to taxes of 1868), all in Madison County in the State of Iowa,

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; To have and to hold the said premises as described, with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever. — And the said parties of the first part, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, doth covenant grant, bargain and agree to and with the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, that at the time of the unsealing and

delivery of these presents, they are well seized of the above granted premises, in Fee simple, that they are free from all incumbrances, whatever; and that they will, and their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, shall Warrant and defend the same against all lawful claims whatsoever.
