and State of Ohio, in consideration of One thousand dollars,
to him paid by John Stouder of the County and State aforesaid,
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby Grant, Bargain,
Sell and Convey to the said John Stouder his heirs and assigns forever,
the following described real estate situate in the State of Iowa Coun-
ty of Madison,

Being South fractional half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of Section number
Nineteen (19) in Township number Seventy five (75) North of Range
number Twenty eight (28) West of fifth (5th) P.M. — Containing
Three hundred and one half Acres more or less.

And all the Estate, Title and Interest of the said Isaac Stouder
either in Law or Equity, of, in and to the said premises; Together
with all the privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging, and
all the rents, issues and profits thereof; To have and to hold the same
to the only proper use of the said John Stouder his heirs and assigns
forever. — And the said Isaac Stouder for himself and for his heirs,
executors and administrators, do hereby covenant with the said John
Stouder his heirs and assigns, that he is the true and lawful owner

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of the said premises, and have full power to convey the same; and that the title, so conveyed, is clear, free and unencumbered; and further, that he will warrant and defend the same against all claim or claims of all persons whomsoever. — In witness whereof, the said Isaac Stouder hath hereunto set his hand and seal, this 24th day of May, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty nine.
