And we do hereby covenant with the said J. B. Heustis that we are lawfully seized of said premises; that they are free from incumbrance; that we have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same; and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises, and appurtenances thereto belonging, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Jennie P. Taylor hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above described premises. —
