W. Smith of Ashtabula County and State of Ohio of the second part,

Witnesseth that the party of the first part, for and in consideration
of the sum of One thousand dollars, in hand paid by the said party
of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Granted,
Bargained and Sold, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and
Convey unto the party of the second part - heirs and assigns the following
described Real Estate, in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit;

The North half of the North East quarter of Section Twenty-four
(24) Township Seventy-four "74" North in Range Twenty-eight "28" West.

Containing Eighty" 80" -- more or less. —

Together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging; To have
and to hold the same unto the said party of the second part -
heirs and assigns forever. — And the said John W. Douglas and
Isabella Douglas party of the first part relinquish unto the said
party of the second part - heirs, executors, administrators and
assigns all their rights, title and interest in and to the above described
premises, and will Warrant and defend the said premises, with
the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, - heirs
and assigns against the lawful claims of them and their heirs,
executors and administrators, or any other person or persons claiming
or to claim, title to the same, or any part thereof; and hereby Covenant
to Warrant and defend the aforesaid lands and appurtenances to
the said party of the second part against all persons claiming under,
by, or through them or any other person or persons whatsoever.

been by me examined, separate and apart and out of the hearing of her

of this State, acknowledged that she had freely and voluntarily exe-
cuted the same and relinquished her right of dower to the lands and

Homesteads, without compulsion of her said husband, and that she
