Anderson Rush
That John H. Marley & Delila Marley of
Madison County, and State of Iowa, in consideration of the
sum of Three hundred dollars, in hand paid by Anderson Rush
of Madison County, and State of Iowa, do hereby sell and convey
unto the said Anderson Rush the following described premises,
situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, to-wit:

Ten Acres, Eighty rods East and West, and Twenty rods
North and South, off of the South side of the South West quarter of
the North West quarter of Section Twenty one (21) in Township
Seventy four (74) North of Range Twenty nine (29) West.

And we hereby covenant with the said Anderson Rush that we hold
said premises by title in fee simple; that we have good right and lawful
authority to sell and convey the same; that they are free and clear of all
liens and incumbrances whatsoever; and we covenant to Warrant
and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons
whomsoever; and the said Delila Marley hereby relinquish her
right of dower in and to the above described premises.
