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This Indenture, Made this fourteenth day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Sixty nine,

Between, Mary S. Harriott of the County of Mercer & State of Illinois and Nathaniel Harriott of Warren County Illinois parties of the first part, and John B. Martin of the County of Warren aforesaid party of the second part, - Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand Dollars in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained and Sold, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain and Sell, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the following described lots, pieces, or parcels of land, situated in Township numbered seventy five, in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The East half of the South East quarter of Section Thirty, in Township Seventy five and Range Twenty eight, containing Eighty Acres be the same more or less. - Also the North half of North East quarter,

of Section Thirty one, in Township Seventy five, and in Range Seventy eight containing Eighty Acres, ^{be the same} more or less. - - And also the North half of the South half of the North East quarter of said Section Thirty one in Township Seventy five and in Range Seventy eight, containing forty Acres be the same more or less. -

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof; and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim and demand whatsoever, of the said party of the first part, either in law or equity, of in and to the above bargained premises, with the hereditaments and appurtenances; To have and to hold the said premises above bargained and described, with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns Forever. - And the said Mary S. Harriott and Nathaniel Harriott parties of the first part, hereby expressly waive, release and relinquish, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, all right, title, claim, interest and benefit whatever, in and to the above described premises, and each and every part thereof, which is given by or results from all laws of the said State of Iowa pertaining to the exemption of homesteads,

And the said Mary S. Harriott and Nathaniel Harriott party of the first part, for themselves and their heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant, grant, bargain and agree, to and with the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, that at the time of the executing and delivery of these presents, they are well seized of the premises above conveyed, as of a good, sure, perfect, absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in law, and in fee simple, and have good right, full power and lawful authority to grant, bargain, sell and convey the same in manner and form aforesaid and that the same are free and clear from all former and other grants, bargains, sales, liens, taxes, assessments and encumbrances, of what kind or nature soever, and the above bargained premises, in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against all and every person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the whole or any part thereof, the said party of the first part shall and will Warrant and forever defend.
